St Paul's Wholeness Centre / Counselling and Therapy Opportunities

We have currently ceased to offer all face to face therapy and counseling until restrictions ease, which we hope will be in the not too distant future.

We are pleased, however, to have been able to move to a 'remote' counseling and therapy service (telephone/other internet-based platforms) for those who are currently receiving support through the Centre and this is working well for many of our clients.

If you are looking for therapeutic support at this time and are interested in exploring whether this remote way of working might suit you, then an initial appointment would help you decide. Ealing Foodbank / August update

The Foodbank is needed more than ever at this time. In July approximately 140% more people were fed compared to July 2019. Foodbank cafes are currently closed, and they are only distributing food for those with food vouchers from their central warehouse between 10-12am on Monday, Tuesday, Thursday, Friday & Saturday.

They have set Wednesday, 10am-4pm, aside as a day for delivery of donations. For August they are looking for the following items:

Mayo; Ketchup; Tinned vegetables; Tinned fruit; Savoury biscuits & crackers; Tinned rice pudding; Ready-made custard; Chick peas; Kidney beans; Jam; Peanut butter; Cooking oil (250ml, 500ml or 1l); Shower gel; Hair shampoo; Washing powder or liquid (smaller sizes); Nappies (size 4 & 6)
